

## **EVENTS AND TRAINING**

- The first convening will take place September 17th 19th, 2020 with the Alumni
  Powerhouse Networking Conference counted as part of the first convening. Ambassadors
  will be sponsored to attend Annual Global Alumni Powerhouse Networking Conference
  to meet FCN Foundation staff and other FCN Foundation Global Ambassadors in person.
  The APNC will take place in Baltimore, Maryland, September 19th, 2020 at The
  University of Baltimore.
- Even after the 12 month GAP, Ambassadors will continue to have access to the FCN
  Foundation's network of Alumni and will be connected with incoming Global
  Ambassadors moving forward.
- Convenings will be three times/year for two days each and will be held in Maryland. In connection with the convenings, Ambassadors will receive: (i) ground transportation or round-trip coach class airfare to Maryland from the major U.S. airport nearest Ambassadors' residence within the United States; (ii) lodging at a Airbnb (entire home); (iii) two meals per day (breakfast and lunch) and dinner on the night of arrival; and (iv) up to \$60/day reimbursement which covers food and local transportation.
- An opportunity to pitch their business or nonprofit to industry influencers on ('Pitch Day"), which will take place on September 17, 2021 as part of the last convening. Three awards towards start up costs will be given for First (\$10,000), Second (\$5,000) and Third Place (\$2500). Hosts and guests of the event may consist of investors/Nonprofit

Funders, industry experts, potential mentors, FCN Foundation Team Members, and peer Ambassadors

Each Ambassador will receive a Fellowship with the FCN Foundation consisting of the following:

## • LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Through experiential learning led by Nonprofit and For-profit Experts (Convening Speakers, Alumni Coaches and Business Coaches), ambassadors will have the opportunity to focus on their individual development by analyzing their internal belief systems, how these systems were created and how they've influenced where they are in life and where they have been unable to reach

## • START-UP COACHING

Ambassadors will be connected with an Alumni Coach that will serve as an Accountability Partner that will assist them through their personal and professional development through the program.

- Ambassadors will develop a global network of support from individuals who share their foster care/out of home history
- The Ambassador Cohort will have access to each other and share progress and advice through virtual Group Meetings
- Over the course of the Fellowship, Ambassadors will receive at least \$10,000 of in-kind support towards expansion of their nonprofit/for-profit or program.
- Ambassadors will be connected to Business Coaches that will provide in-kind supports in areas including but not limited to grant-writing, legal counsel
